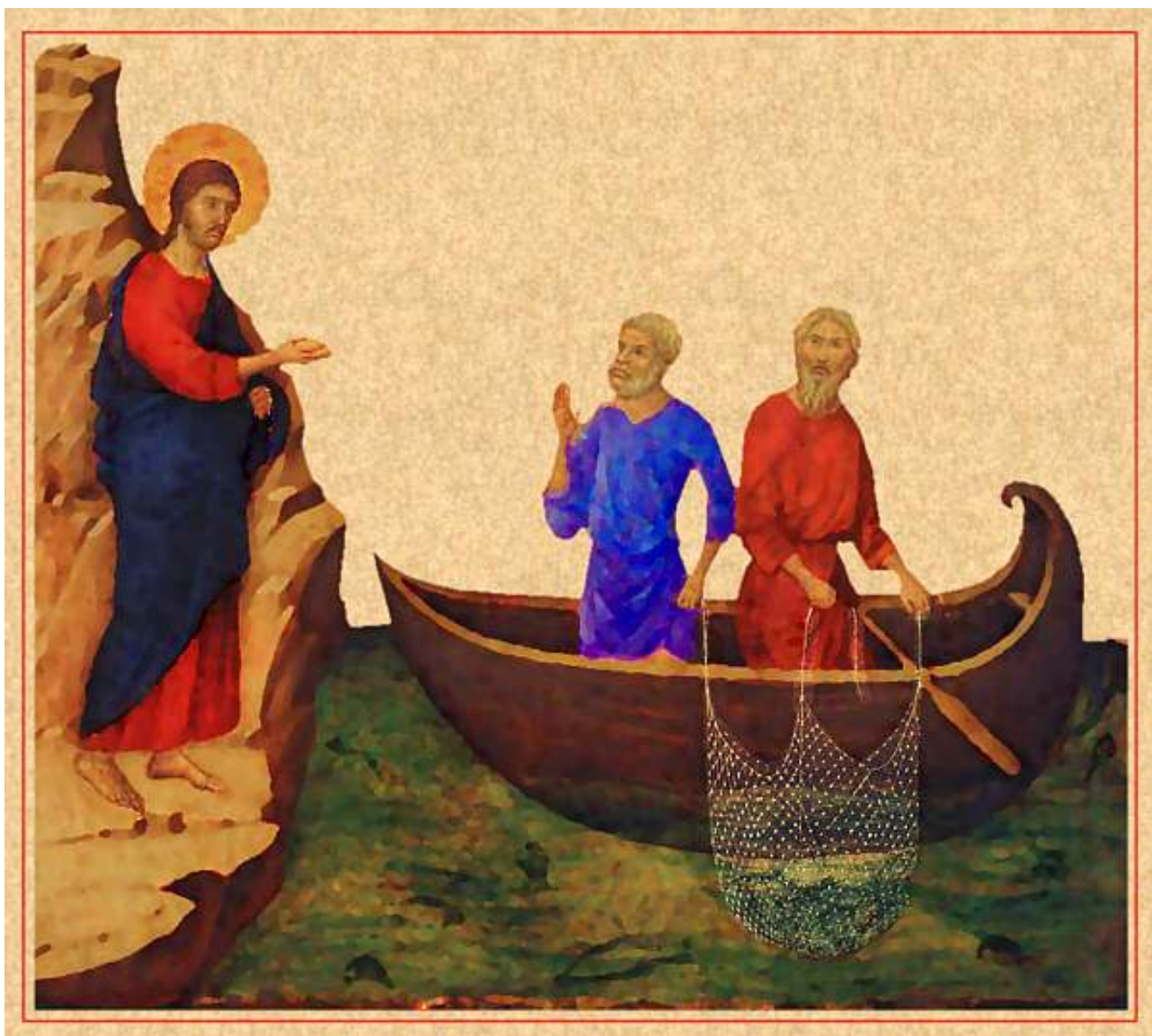

January 22<sup>nd</sup> marked the 42<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion on demand in our country. The anti-abortion movement has gradually shifted its tactics away from aggressive in-your-face demonstrations to discreetly working the state political system, and observers, legal experts and even pro-abortion rights groups admit the strategy is working. Since 2000, state legislatures have passed 435 abortion restrictions nationwide (260 in the past five years alone), a continuous streak of small, strategic and often overlooked anti-abortion victories.

A CDC report confirms there has been a big drop in the number of abortions, to a historic low – 33% of pregnancies used to end in abortion, now it's 18%. For every abortion clinic in our country, there are now 5 pregnancy care centers. Education and pro-life laws are saving lives.

As Catholics we would naturally prefer to live in a country where every citizen, voter and court consistently favor legal recognition of and protection for the unborn. Yet, in the near future, we cannot realistically expect complete agreement among all participants in the abortion debate. We must listen respectfully to others' opinions, just as we expect a fair hearing of our own arguments against abortion. Our confidence in the persuasive power of well articulated defenses of pro-life positions sustains us, even as we acknowledge the long struggle ahead. In the meantime, our common calling is to stand in solidarity with the unborn, the "least of our brothers and sisters" (Mt 25:40), through prayer and political activism.
