If you didn't receive it Saturday, this week you will receive a letter from Bishop Walkowiak. He will be asking you to give 1% of your income to the Catholic Services Appeal.

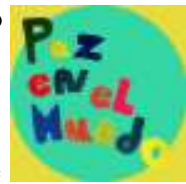
Just a reminder about an update in our practice at St. Gregory Masses. After the Lamb of God our Missal calls for all to kneel. Therefore, we will continue joining the common practice of the Church and kneel rather than stand at that point. Our uniformity with the greater Church will also show hospitality to our summer parishioners and visitors, as they are accustomed to kneeling then. Making it easier to do, for the next few weeks at the right time I'll say: "please kneel".

"When faith is completely replaced by creed, worship by discipline, love by habit; when the crisis of today is ignored because of the splendor of the past; when faith becomes an heirloom rather than a living fountain...its message becomes meaningless."

The famous Rabbi Abraham Heschel, who died in 1972, wrote the above critique of religion. Pope Francis would say "Amen". As a parallel to Rabbi Heschel's criticism of faith being "replaced by creed" and how "the crisis of today is ignored because of the splendor of the past," Francis warned in an interview with Catholic journals that "faith becomes an ideology among other ideologies" in those who long for "an exaggerated doctrinal 'security'; those who stubbornly try to recover a past that no longer exists." Like Rabbi Heschel, Francis wants faith to be a "living fountain" rather than an "heirloom." The pope put it this way: "If the Christian is legalistic, if he/she wants everything safe and clear, then he/she will find nothing. Tradition and memory of the past, must help us have the courage to open up new areas to God."

Al principio de este año, el Papa Francisco ofreció unas reflexiones importantes con motivo de la Jornada Mundial de la Paz, en las que traía a la mente y al corazón realidades importantes y preocupantes. Refiriéndose a la verdad de nuestra fe de que hay un solo Padre común a todos, lo que



hace a todos los seres humanos hermanos, comentaba que no puede haber paz si unos "hermanos" se sitúan sobre otros como dueños y dominadores. Hablaba de que, aunque la esclavitud se abolió legalmente, aún existen muchos esclavos en la actualidad. Entre ellos se refirió a: • Los trabajadores oprimidos de manera formal o informal en todos los sectores, desde el trabajo doméstico hasta la agricultura, la industria o la minería donde la legislación laboral no cumple con las normas. • Los emigrantes que sufren abusos durante su viaje, que luego pasan a las sombras del temor y que aceptan vivir en condiciones inadmisibles con el fin de alcanzar el sueño de una vida mejor para sus familias. • Las personas que se sienten obligadas a ejercer la prostitución, entre las que se encuentran menores, esclavas y esclavos sexuales o jóvenes obligadas a casarse. • Los niños y adultos víctimas del tráfico de órganos. • Los secuestrados y encerrados en cautividad por grupos terroristas. • Los niños soldados quienes muchas veces son vendidos, torturados, mutilados o asesinados. Aunque éstas son palabras pronunciadas ya en enero, no dejan de ser actuales y de desafío a los cristianos de manera permanente, en tanto que existan estas formas de esclavitud.

Aunque no hay muchos documentos históricos, se asocia a San Marcos con varios detalles significativos; uno es que, según se dice, la casa donde se celebró la Última Cena pertenecía a su familia. También se afirma que era primo de San Bernabé y que acompañó a éste y a San Pablo en algunos de los viajes apostólicos. Luego regresó a su patria. Parece que era algo así como el secretario de San Pedro y de él aprendió los detalles de la vida de Jesús, que luego transcribió en su evangelio. Aunque es el más corto de los evangelios, es del suyo de donde toman mucho material los demás sinópticos (Mateo y Lucas). Era hombre de confianza de Pedro y de Pablo. Parece que fue nombrado obispo de Alejandría, donde sufrió el martirio.
