Now is a time of great transition for our Catholic brothers and sisters serving in the United States Military. While many are home with their families in the wake of troop withdrawals from the Middle East, others remain on the front lines to face a scattered but determined enemy. Those still deployed endure ongoing adversity, sacrifice and danger. Those back home confront major life adjustments—always aware they could be called back to action at any time, as are others who have yet to experience combat. Facing so many kinds of hardship, these Catholics in uniform rely on the priests who serve as military chaplains for spiritual support, guidance in faith and access to the sacraments.



How can we, as witnesses to the Gospel, be there for our fellow Catholics who put so much on the line to defend our Country? Last year, the USCCB approved a new national collection to support the Archdiocese for the Military Services responsible for supplying priests to serve as chaplains in the U.S. military.

This collection offers each of us a substantial way to “*serve those who serve.*” Funds raised will help the Archdiocese and its endorsed priests bring the Church’s full range of pastoral services to the men and women in uniform as well as their families and patients in the VA Medical Centers. It will support religious education, priestly formation of new chaplains, and financial planning to meet the challenges of shepherding a global Archdiocese. The Archdiocese receives no government funding.

Why Support the Archdiocese for the Military Services?

The AMS (Archdiocese for the Military Services) is the ONLY source of Catholic chaplains for the U.S. military and VA Medical Centers. Despite increased demand, the ranks of active-duty Catholic priest-chaplains have dropped from 400 around the time of 9/11/2001 to about 250 due to priests reaching retirement faster than they can be replaced.

- ◆ The AMS serves 1.8 million Catholics worldwide with only 500 ordained priests—they need your support! Catholics make up roughly 25% of the military, but only 8% of military chaplains are Catholic. Often, our young Catholic servicemen and women turn to other denominations for pastoral care due to lack of Catholic priests.
- ◆ The AMS receives no government funding. Archbishop Timothy P. Broglio presides over the AMS. He and his four auxiliary bishops travel the world spending 65% of their time visiting the flock, all AMS expense. The AMS offers catechesis and faith formation to servicemen and women and their families.
- ◆ The AMS has no parishes to take up collections. The AMS owns no parishes or schools or physical buildings besides the chancery seat of the Archdiocese in Washington, DC.
- ◆ The AMS depends entirely on generous donors like you for survival. The Archdiocese depends solely on generous donations from the general public, from current and retired priest-chaplains, and from private grants.

LOS CAPELLANES MILITARES CATÓLICOS SIRVEN A AQUELLOS QUE SIRVEN

Ellos son la última línea de defensa espiritual para los hombres y mujeres que luchan en nuestras guerras. Bendicen a nuestras tropas con el poder sanador de los Sacramentos y del buen consejo. Ellos necesitan de SU APOYO.

Unos 250 capellanes católicos en el servicio activo hoy en día. Ellos atienden a los católicos en las Fuerzas Armadas y las academias militares del país. Otros 250 capellanes católicos sirven a pacientes en los 153 Centros Médicos de la Administración de Salud de Veteranos (VA). En total, 1.8 millones de católicos y sus familias dependen de casi 500 capellanes para su sustento espiritual.

Los capellanes ESCASEAN...A pesar de la creciente demanda, el total de capellanes católicos en servicio activo ha caído de 400 alrededor del 9/11/2001 a unos 250, debido a que los sacerdotes llegan a la edad de retiro con mayor rapidez que su reemplazo.

Los católicos conforman casi el 25% del ejército, pero solo el 8% de los capellanes militares son católicos. Con frecuencia, nuestros jóvenes hombres y mujeres católicos en servicio recurren a otras denominaciones para su cuidado pastoral debido a la carencia de sacerdotes católicos.

El llamando a evangelizar a adultos jóvenes en el servicio activo sigue siendo el foco primordial de la AMS. La Oficina de Evangelización apoya a capellanes, líderes laicos y a coordinadores de ministerios para que satisfagan las necesidades pastorales de esta generación joven, que necesita oír la Palabra de dios proclamada genuina y valientemente.

Brindar a estos hombres y mujeres jóvenes, que con frecuencia tienen grandes necesidades espirituales, en su viaje por la vida, un encuentro con Jesucristo y Su Iglesia a través del ministerio de la AMS, es cumplir con el llamado de ser “*embajadores de Cristo, como si Dios mismo les exhortara por nuestra boca.*” 2 Corintios 5, 20

La única Arquidiócesis global con el mayor territorio geográfico... El Arzobispo Timothy P. Broglio preside la Arquidiócesis para los Servicios Militares (AMS). Él y sus cuatro obispos auxiliares viajan por el mundo dedicando el 65% de su tiempo a visitar su rebaño, todo a cargo de AMS. La AMS ofrece catequesis y formación en la fe a los hombres y mujeres en el servicio y a sus familias además de conservar más de 2.5 millones de registros de sacramentos que datan desde 1917.

Pero hay más seminaristas en camino... gracias al apoyo de nuestros obispos, de los superiores religiosos, y a una mayor conciencia y a oportunidades de discernimiento, más hombres jóvenes que ahora ingresan a seminarios se hacen capellanes a través del Programa de Seminaristas Copatrocinados, que cubre los costos de educación de un seminarista entre la diócesis local y la Arquidiócesis para los Servicios Militares (AMS).

Los fondos de la misión de la AMS dependen de usted... la AMS no posee parroquias, ni escuelas ni edificios salvo la sede de archivos eclesiásticos de la Arquidiócesis en Washington, DC.
