Dear friends in Christ,

In March, the parishes of our diocese will be taking up the Catholic Relief Services (CRS) collection. This collection funds six Catholic agencies that work to serve our suffering brothers and sisters around the world. These agencies provide a broad range of services, including advocating for immigrants, providing humanitarian aid, resettling displaced individuals, and working for increased peace in our world. Your support of this collection creates the opportunity to provide help and hope to all those who are the face of "Jesus in disguise."

People like orphaned Afghani refugees like Aazar and Ali. After their family members were killed, the boys fled to Pakistan, but were separated. Unable to locate his brother, Aazar continued on to Iraq and then Turkey where he was granted refugee status. In 2012, he received a referral to be placed in the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Unaccompanied Refugee Minor (URM) program, bringing him to the United States.

Upon arriving in the United States, Aazar reached out to the BBC, which held a nightly radio program broadcast in the Middle East to find missing persons, for help in finding Ali. Within one week, his brother was found alive in Pakistan. After nine years of separation, the brothers were reunited through the USCCB's Migration and Refugee Services (MRS) and could begin to resettle and reconnect as family.



Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Durante el mes de Marzo las parroquias de nuestra diócesis van a recoger la colecta de Catholic Relief Services (CRS). Dicha colecta patrocina seis agencias católicas que trabajan para servir a nuestros hermanos y hermanas que sufren alrededor del mundo. Estas agencias proveen un rango muy amplio de servicios, entre otros, apoyo a los inmigrantes, asistencia humanitaria, acompañamiento para personas desplazadas y trabajo por la paz en el mundo. Su apoyo para esta colecta crea oportunidades de ayuda y esperanza para todos aquellos que son el rostro de Jesús.

Personas como los huérfanos y refugiados Afghanos: Aazar y Ali. Después de que sus familiares fueron asesinados, los niños huyeron a Pakistán pero fueron separados, Aazar buscó a su hermano sin éxito, se fue a Irak y luego a Turquía donde le concedieron status de refugiado. En el 2012, recibió una referencia para tomar parte en el programa de niños refugiados *Unaccompanied Refugee Minor* (URM) que coordina la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de Estados Unidos (USCCB), y de ese modo llegó a Estados Unidos. Una vez en Estados Unidos, Aazar contactó a BBC, emisora radial que trasmite en el Medio Oriente un programa nocturno para encontrar a personas desaparecidas, el objetivo de Aazar era encontrar a Ali. Esa misma semana Ali fue encontrado en Pakistán. Después de nueve años de separación, los hermanos fueron reunidos nuevamente como familia a través del servicio de Inmigración y Refugiados que provee la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de Estados Unidos.

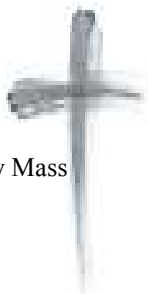

A little over a week ago Shelby H.S. cancelled a basketball game scheduled at Muskegon Heights. A Grand Rapids, not Muskegon, young man shot people in the Heights Feb. 9th, resulting in fear and trepidation on the part of Shelby student-athletes' parents.

I witnessed similar fear on the part of the outlying community when I lived three years at Sacred Heart, Muskegon Heights in the mid 1980's. But in the entire time I was there, nothing happened to anyone attending the parish; no violence was seen or experienced. The image outsiders had of the Heights was incorrect.

In 1984 when the Tigers won the World Series, I saw seven regular season games at Tiger Stadium in Detroit. I did not heed the cautionary concerns that Corktown, the vicinity of Tiger Stadium, was a dangerous place. I knew better, and never had any problems in that poor and Black neighborhood. The image was wrong.

From 1994 to 2003 I was Rector of the Cathedral of St Andrew, and often was cautioned to stay away from the violent types and drug dealers (outsiders' descriptions) that blanketed the neighborhood.

It's true that the rectory was broken into three times in one month while I was there. The perpetrators had broken into up to one hundred places, according to GR police. Eventually, they were found, caught and jailed. They were two white kids from the suburbs. Again, the image did not match the life lived there, residents having nothing to do with the crimes. But due to false or incorrect reports, and a false image of all "those people" being dangerous, fear gripped the outlying white community.

#### **Fear fades when we befriend people of color.**

That's what I know. To be fair, what I don't know is a parent's impulse to protect their child(ren). I don't have the full picture. Yet from where I sit it appears that fear overwhelmed the parents of athletes at Shelby H.S., making them decide to push to cancel a basketball game. Sadly, I believe Hart H.S. parents would have done the same. I've seen this before, too many times and in too many places. Thus, I praise Kalamazoo Lakeside Academy for subbing at the last moment so Muskegon Heights could play a final home game.

Caution is one thing. Letting fear dictate our actions is another. The only fear we're encouraged to strive for as Christians is the Fear of the Lord. In that case, fear is a primary reverence and awe of our Creator to whom we constantly strive to draw near. Let's continue our goal this Lent of focusing our actions and lives on living in the love of our God. A good place to start is: first, remembering that God created all persons; and second, showing them proper respect.

Continuamos la Cuaresma durante todo este mes de marzo, con un reto a profundizar más y más en la vida de Cristo y en nuestra identidad como bautizados. En el cuarto domingo de Cuaresma, con el relato del hijo pródigo, se nos invita a considerar nuestra identidad como hijos de Dios y a dar gracias por el perdón incondicional que recibimos, así como a extender el perdón generoso a todos los que nos han hecho daño. En el quinto domingo, se nos habla de la observancia de leyes y se nos llama a comenzar de nuevo siempre fiados en la misericordia de Dios. El Domingo de Ramos nos hace un desafío al testimonio fiel a Cristo, a un seguimiento que no se queda en un momento de entusiasmo, sino que continúa a través de dificultades y persecuciones.

Luego tenemos los días más importantes del año cristiano; el Jueves Santo, la celebración de la institución de la eucaristía, el mandato de servicio del Jueves Santo y la celebración del sacerdocio; el Viernes Santo, conmemoración de la Pasión y muerte del Señor, con todas las liturgias eclesiales y populares; el Sábado Santo, con la Vigilia Pascual, la celebración del Bautismo; y la celebración de la Pascua que está llena de contenido y riqueza.

En estados Unidos ocupa un lugar preferente la fiesta de San Patricio (día 17). La celebración de la comunidad irlandesa se extiende ahora a todas las comunidades, que celebran al santo devoto de la Trinidad. Patricio celebró la presencia de Cristo entre, con, delante, detrás, y sobre todos los cristianos. El 19 se celebra san José, muy querido por las comunidades italiana y polaca, patrono universal de la Iglesia y elaborador muy cercano en la vida e historia humana de Jesús.
