HAPPY ANNIVERSARY OF ORDINATION

The Pope is deeply concerned about the plight of Christians and other minorities in the Middle East, particularly in Syria and Iraq. He spoke forcefully about this in St. Peter's Basilica on April 12 at a Mass about the centenary of the genocide of Armenians. He sees a disturbing parallel between what happened to them, the world's first Christian nation, during World War I and what's happening to Christians in the Middle East today, also at "a time of war, a third world war that is being fought piecemeal, one in which we daily witness savage crimes, brutal massacres and senseless destruction."

"Sadly, today too," he said, "We hear the muffled and forgotten cry of so many of our defenseless brothers and sisters who, on account of their faith in Christ or their ethnic origin, are publicly and ruthlessly put to death—decapitated, crucified, burned alive—or forced to leave their homeland."

"Today too," he stated, "we are experiencing a sort of genocide created by general and collective indifference, by the complicit silence of Cain, who cries out: 'What does it matter to me? Am I my brother's keeper?'"

The Pope's reference to Armenia recalls the 1915 Turkish extermination campaign of 1.5 million Armenians killed. Raphael Lemke, the scholar who coined the word *genocide*, invented it in response to the details of the anti-Armenian campaign by the Turks. The torture was barbarous and the Turks' campaign was fueled by religious contempt. Although the Pope recently displeased Turkey's government for naming it, it has rightly been categorized as our first modern genocide.

Today even the dead, it seems, cannot escape Islamic State extremism. Militants, who have been in control of Mosul, Iraq since June, began toppling tombstones and crosses in the city's oldest Christian cemetery - part of a campaign to "eradicate pagan symbols".

Returning from Korea last August, Pope Francis told the press: "It's licit to stop the unjust aggressor. I underline the verb stop. I do not say bomb, make war...I say stop by some means." He said those means "have to be evaluated" at the United Nations. "One nation alone cannot judge how to stop an unjust aggressor."

Will today's leaders listen to Francis?

Parents of Martin Richard, the 8 year-old boy killed in the Boston Marathon bombings of April 2013, called on the government recently to end its quest for the death penalty and sentence the convicted bomber to life in prison. The Richards are setting an example of a non-violent response to violence by asking for justice, not vengeance.

Hace unos meses, una delegación del comité de migraciones de la conferencia de Obispos de Estados Unidos viajó a Turquía, Bulgaria y Grecia para evaluar el impacto de la crisis de refugiados sirios en esos países. Además de los refugiados sirios, esos países también albergan a personas de Iraq, Afganistán, Congo, Somalia, Eritrea, Sudán y otros lugares.



Los objetivos eran expresar solidaridad con los que buscan asilo, fortalecer las asociaciones con ministerios migratorios católicos y comprender mejor los desafíos y posibles soluciones relacionadas a la protección, necesidades humanitarias y soluciones duraderas para los refugiados. La delegación presentó un informe de 44 páginas en las que estudia la situación de los diversos países afectados y presenta algunas recomendaciones para soluciones sostenibles.

Los obispos urgen a la comunidad internacional a proporcionar más asistencia a esos países, que están al borde de una fuerte crisis al no poder responder a las necesidades de tan altos números de refugiados. Se calcula que la guerra en Siria ha generado una migración de más de 550,000, con una población desplazada de sus lugares de residencia de 7.6 millones. En Iraq, habría más de 1.9 millones de desplazados y migrantes.

De especial atención para la comisión es la situación de los menores que viajan solos y para los que existen pocos mecanismos de protección. También comenta el informe la situación de minorías religiosas perseguidas, como los cristianos asirios y caldeos y los Yazidis. Los obispos urgen a una movilización para responder a una crisis de tales proporciones y piden a la comunidad internacional que proporcione más auxilio inmediato y en la relocalización de los refugiados.
