This past week the Vatican released the details of Pope Francis' trip in September to the U.S.

Macroeconomist Jeffrey Sacks has thoughts on what the Pope may say. I offer my summary of his analysis.

Pope Francis has declared that the joy of the Gospel can help the world to overcome indifference to others. Undoubtedly, he will bring this message when he visits the United States in September. But when he does, he will face a society in thrall to a different idea—that of the unalienable rights to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. The urgent core of Francis' message, which is the message of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, challenges this American idea by proclaiming that the path to happiness lies not solely or mainly through the defense of rights but through the exercise of virtues, most notably justice and charity.

Pope Francis sees a crisis of the human spirit in our time, characterized by our inability to hear the suffering of others.

In the United States, we learn that the route to happiness lies in the rights of the individual. For Jesus, as in the Beatitudes, the path to happiness is through the exercise of virtue, which means the right kind of living by each individual as a member of society. Jesus' message is that happiness, and indeed salvation, cannot be found through material goods, or through the pursuit of happiness as consumers and moneychangers, but through the virtues of humility and justice, including most importantly "feeding the least among you."

The church teaches that an individual's happiness can be achieved only in solidarity with the community, in the individual's "firm and persevering determination to commit one-self to the common good," in the words of Pope John Paul II.

As the church's social doctrine declares, "The human person cannot find fulfillment in himself, that is, apart from the fact that he exists 'with' others and 'for' others" - a fact supported by psychological studies confirming that the act of giving is a powerful spur to an individual's sense of well-being.

Yet in today's America, the very idea of virtue has been privatized, individualized and increasingly commercialized. Each individual is at liberty to define virtue as he or she sees fit.

The results are disturbing. Trust between Americans is waning, as is recorded each year in survey evidence. A pall of corruption hangs over government, banking and other parts of the economy, even the health care sector. Americans are richer but no happier. Yet even as the United States has become more unequal in income and wealth than at any other time in its modern history, those supporting individual rights—or libertarians—argue that the widening gulf between rich and poor gives no cause for any policy response. In the name of individual rights, the poor are left to suffer and the super-rich are excused from the requirements of virtue and common decency.

Pope Francis is not coming as a scold but as a guide, to help us find happiness greater than what would be found in one more purchase and one more possession. He is not rejecting the libertarian defense of human dignity but saying that dignity is found not only through individual rights and free markets but from within, by each person pursuing the virtues of charity, justice and compassion in solidarity with the common good. This, after all, is the message of hope that brought the multitudes to hear Jesus preach.

The pope may preach in September that we are trapped by indifference, magnified by America's exaggerated defense of liberty at the expense of virtue. Words do matter; and the Gospel teachings about the path to happiness through compassion, can become our guideposts back to safety.

En el mes de julio se celebran muchas fiestas de santos notables y este año con relevancia especial, la figura de Junípero Serra, fundador de más de diez misiones en California. Será canonizado en Septiembre por el Papa Francisco. Otros santos de especial interés son María Goretti, Teresa de los Andes, Buenaventura, Kateri Tekakwitha, Francisco Solano, Santiago el Mayor, Joaquín y Ana, e Ignacio de Loyola, entre otros. Se celebra en julio Nuestra Señora de Chiquinquirá, patrona de Colombia y muy venerada también en Venezuela, y Nuestra Señora del Carmen, patrona de Chile y de todos los que trabajan en el mar.



#### **NUESTRA SEÑORA DE CHIQUINQUIRÁ,**

patrona de Colombia: En el siglo XVI, los frailes dominicos evangelizaban el territorio colombiano. Un español, Antonio de Santana, recibió la encomienda de construir una casa para la administración de colonos e indígenas de la región de Chiquinquirá. En la hacienda debería haber también una capilla. Los frailes consideraron que en la capilla debería haber una representación de la Virgen del Rosario; un pintor la termino y el 1562 quedo instalada en la capilla. En 1574 se abandono esa capilla y el cuadro quedo abandonado y prácticamente destruido por la humedad. En 1585 María Ramos decidió restaurarlo, pero aunque lo situó en un lugar de honor y lo limpio, estaba desdibujado y dañado. Un día, Isabel, una mujer indígena vio como el cuadro brillaba y los colores se habían restaurado milagrosamente. Desde entonces es objeto de la devoción del pueblo colombiano. Se venera también en Venezuela.
