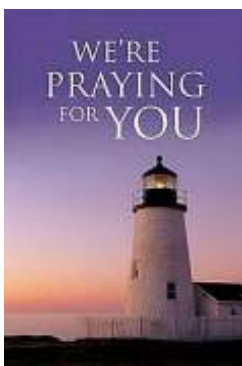

In “The Joy of Love,” Pope Francis reminds readers that while new technologies can be a force for good, they can also place the most vulnerable at risk. “We cannot ignore the risks that these new forms of communication pose for children and adolescents,” Francis says, adding that technology “exposes them more easily to manipulation by those who would invade their private space with selfish interests”. According to a study from the GSM Association, an organization that represents mobile operators around the world, more than 60 percent of children worldwide are using digital tools; as this number rises, so does the risk of children falling prey to online abuses, from bullying to grooming by sexual predators.



As our reliance on technology grows, Pope Francis reminds us we should always keep in mind the safety of our world’s youngest.

Speaking to judges and prosecutors at a Vatican summit on human trafficking and modern slavery on June 3, Pope Francis said, “You are responsible for executing justice,” the ones “called to give hope.” The pope had been given a warm welcome by some 100 judges and prosecutors from all over the world. They had spent the day sharing experiences dealing with cases of human trafficking and making proposals for national and transnational action to combat these crimes, which have made victims of an estimated 40 million men, women and children. After thanking them for the work they are doing in this field, often in difficult and sometimes dangerous circumstances, Pope Francis encouraged them “to fulfill their vocation and their crucial mission—to establish justice—without which there is neither order nor sustainable and integral development, nor social peace.” He emphasized the importance of their work in defense of “the dignity and freedom of men and women today” and in particular “to eradicate human trafficking and smuggling and the new forms of slavery such as forced labor, prostitution, organ trafficking, the drug trade and organized crime.” He denounced these forms of modern slavery as “real crimes against humanity.”

As we celebrate our freedom this long weekend, we are thankful to those who serve(d) and sacrifice(d) to insure that freedom. And along with Pope Francis, we offer our prayer, solidarity, and advocacy for those who are least free among us. Have a safe and happy Fourth.

Estamos en pleno tiempo ordinario y verano, y parece como si no pasara nada; sin embargo, este tiempo ofrece muchas oportunidades litúrgicas.

En muchas ciudades, las pequeñas comunidades de fe aprovechan el buen tiempo para dar un testimonio público de su fe e invitar a los alejados, celebrando la eucaristía en las calles de sus barrios. Tal actividad evangelizadora está muy de acuerdo con las lecturas de estos domingos, que invitan a un compromiso radical y envían a la misión de Jesús en la vida diaria y en las ciudades. De nuevo, se da una progresión en los evangelios de estos domingos: la aceptación de la misión y el envío a sembrar va seguida de una llamada a hacer el bien a todos. El pasaje del evangelio sobre Marta y María llama a una verdadera hospitalidad como virtud central cristiana; y, por último, hay una llamada a dejarse convertir por la oración que Dios quiere de nosotros.

Todo esto representa un ciclo de profundización en la vida cristiana, que se repite a lo largo del año en los distintos tiempos litúrgicos, pero que durante el tiempo ordinario proporciona una ocasión especial de aplicación a la vida diaria.

En este mes, Chile y Colombia celebran a María bajo las advocaciones del Carmen y Chiquinquirá, respectivamente. En estados Unidos se celebra el Día de la Independencia, un buen momento para la reflexión sobre la libertad y la justicia. Además, celebramos santos importantes por su influencia en la evangelización en América, como santa Teresa de los Andes y santa Kateri Tekakwitha.

### NUESTRA SENORA DE ITALI

Los sacerdotes franciscanos que sembraron la semilla evangélica en la provincia de Corrientes, Argentina llevaron consigo una imagen de la Virgen María. En 1615, un grupo de aborígenes que no estaba de acuerdo con la obra evangelizadora de los franciscanos se llevó la imagen y esta desapareció sin dejar rastro. Tiempo después varios indios devotos la encontraron sobre una piedra blanca a orillas del río Paraná, envuelta por una luz y una música inexplicables. Los indios llevaron la imagen al franciscano Fray Luis de Bolaños; pero esta volvió a desaparecer y fue encontrada nuevamente en el mismo lugar, sobre la piedra blanca (que en guaraní se dice itatí). El clérigo interpretó que la voluntad de la Virgen era quedarse allí y mudó el pueblo a ese lugar. En la Semana Santa de 1624 se transfiguró el rostro de la imagen y a partir de ahí numerosos milagros han sido atribuidos a su intercesión.

La imagen de la Virgen de Itatí fue solemnemente coronada y entronizada con el nombre de Reina del Paraná y Reina del Amor el 16 de julio de 1900. El Santuario de Itatí es uno de los más importantes de América y cada año alrededor de dos millones y medio de fieles lo visitan, para manifestarle su amor y devoción.
